Mary Seacole was a **nurse**. Her mother was Jamaican and her father was Scottish. She travelled from Jamaica to look after wounded **soldiers** on the **battlefield** in the **Crimean War**. She set up a **hospital** called the British Hotel to look after **soldiers**.

Florence Nightingale was a **nurse**. She made **hospitals** cleaner for **patients** and looked after **soldiers** in the **Crimean War**. She set up the Nightingale Training School for **nurses** in 1860.



We will be learning about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole as pioneering nurses from the past. We will make comparisons between the two ladies and look at the impact they had on modern day nursing.
