Mary Seacole was a **nurse**. Her mother was Jamaican and her father was Scottish. She travelled from Jamaica to look after wounded **soldiers** on the **battlefield** in the **Crimean War**. She set up a **hospital** called the British Hotel to look after **soldiers**.

Florence Nightingale was a nurse. She made hospitals cleaner for patients and looked after soldiers in the Crimean War. She set up the Nightingale Training School for nurses in 1860.



We will be learning about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole as pioneering nurses from the past. We will make comparisons between the two ladies and look at the impact they had on modern day nursing.

Our History lessons will work on developing good enquiry skills. We will look at different sources of information and think about the reliability and usefulness of each source, considering how we know about things that happened in the past.
