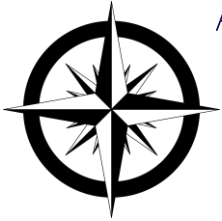


This half term our science unit of learning will be 'Our Local Counties'.

A compass has eight points: North, North East, East, South East, South, South West, West and North West.

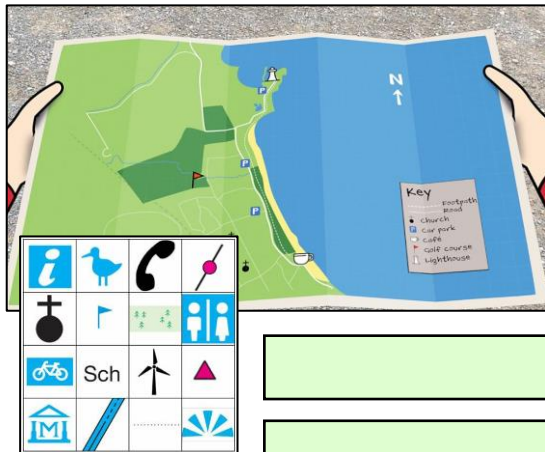
Wellington is located in the county of Somerset in the South-West of England. It borders the counties of Devon, Dorset, Wiltshire, Bristol and Gloucestershire.
